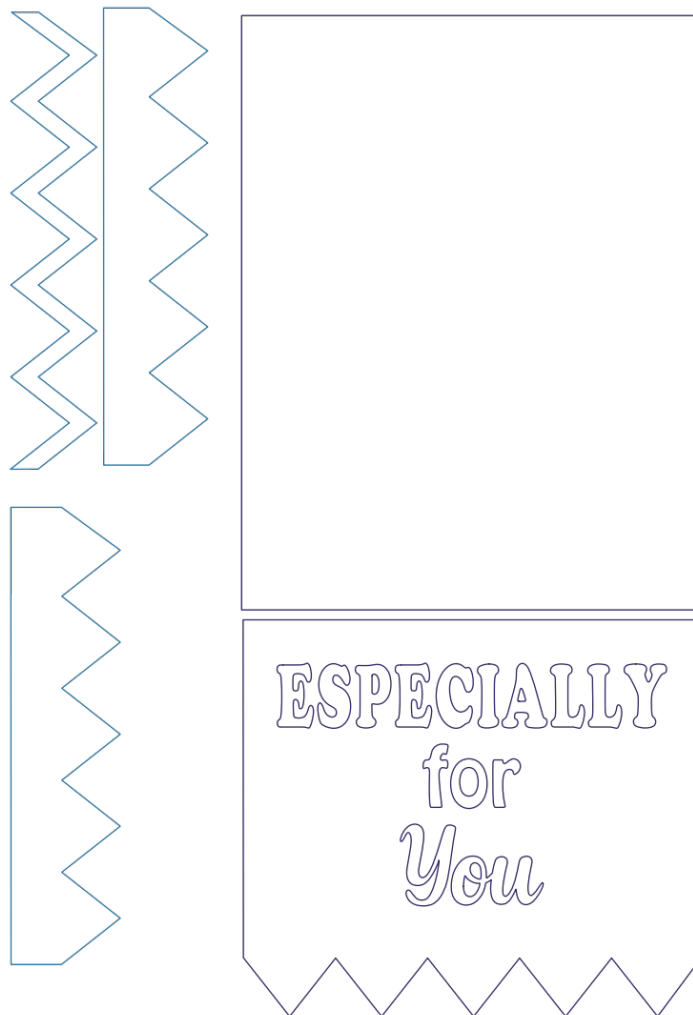


3d Text Card Instructions:

IMPORTANT:

Load the SVG files into your cutting software ensuring that the file width matches that in the name of the file – For example - “*3d Especially For You 7.543.svg*”. Your file should be 7.543 inches wide.

Cut out the 5 pieces of the card file so you will have the plain base card piece, the patterned topper with the letters cut out (*important - keep the letters including the middles*) the contrasting zigzag border and the two wider zigzag layers to put underneath the border if desired.



See example below of card design pieces from the file:

Base Card Piece



Card Topper

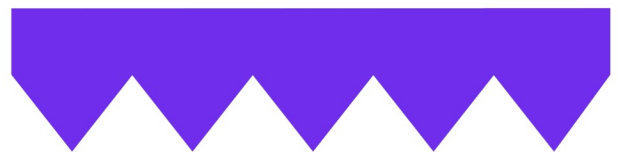


Narrow zig-zag border

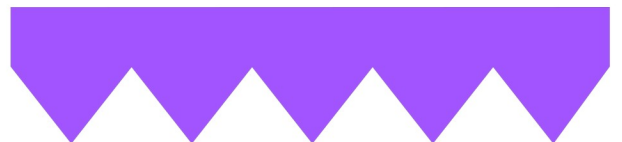
Left over cut out letters

When these pieces are cut out and put together (not the letters), they will look like this and TIP: for extra dimension you can put the made up patterned pieces and borders on foam tape before adding it to the base card piece. It creates a lovely shadow (see photos at the end)!



You will still have the left over cut out letters

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And now open the second 3D text SVG file that has four identical copies of the text. Remember to adjust the file to the correct width (in the name of the file). You can choose whether to cut three or all four copies depending on the dimension you would like.

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So you now have three/four cutouts of the plain text and one of the left over patterned text. Glue together all 3 or 4 layers of each individual plain letter followed by it's patterned layer on top to give you some three dimensional letters (see below) and then glue each 3D letter into it's corresponding empty space on the card front

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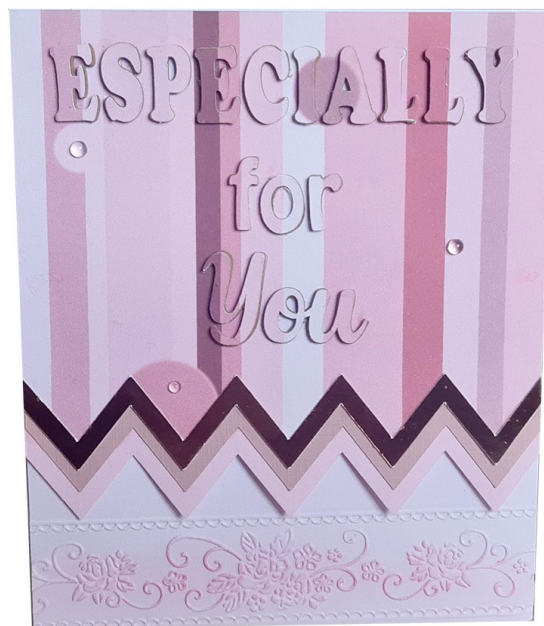
ESPECIALLY
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When they are all glued into place your Card front should look as below:



All that is left to do is adhere this completed card front to your card blank and write your greeting in the inside of the card. Have fun!

These are the cards we made with the files and they look gorgeous! We did emboss the base card piece for extra interest but you can decorate it however you like if at all!
